

Developmental Disability Mill Levy Grant 2024

We would like to inform you about the 2024 Developmental Disability Mill Levy Grant (DDML), a funding opportunity designed to support agencies currently serving Douglas County residents with intellectual or developmental disabilities (IDD), as well as those interested in initiating services for this population.

Since its inception in 2001, the DDML grant has allocated more than \$5 million in funding to local services dedicated to supporting individuals with an IDD. We welcome all local agencies serving the IDD population to apply for these funds. We particularly encourage applicants with new, innovative programs that address existing service gaps to consider submitting their proposals.

It is important to note that the County aims to grant funds for programs, projects, or scholarships directly benefiting residents, rather than covering administrative costs or operating expenses.

To ensure that you are well-prepared for the application process, we will be providing DDML grant application training through a pre-recorded video this year. The video will be made available on the [DDML website](#) before the application's opening date. The application period will commence on June 14th and conclude on July 15th.
