We meet at the Autism Community Store, which is not far from the Aurora Metro Center Bus/Train Station, as well as on Zoom for those unable to attend in-person. Visit MAC to see what we're like!

Meetings begin with a warm up and are broken into two halves, with a short break in the middle. During the first half we do introductions, share resources, and discuss various topics. The second half is more social and sometimes we play games. Some meetings will feature guest speakers. Free food and drinks are available at in-person meetings.

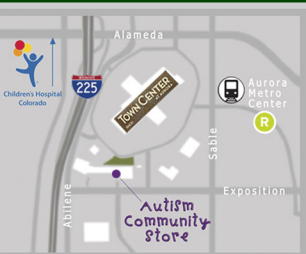
