The PASCO Family Caregiver Program

PASCO has been providing services and supports since 1992. Founder Barry Rosenberg collaborated with parent advocates and Colorado lawmakers in 2001 to establish a program so family members can be paid to deliver care to a loved one.

There are **4 ways** to access the Family Caregiver Program



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Family Member as a CNA (Certified Nursing Assistant)

A family member can become a CNA caregiver and support their family as a PASCO employee.

IHSS Attendant

(In Home Support Services)

Bypass CNA school and provide qualifying services at CNA level and above.

Pediatric Personal Care

This program gives the parent a break and pays someone they trust - a friend or relative – to provide care as a PASCO employee.

Intellectual / Developmental Disabilities


As a Direct Service Provider (DSP) a family member works with their loved one to develop greater long-term independence.
