REVEL's Educational and Vocational Upward Placement program

WHO

This class is designed to apply to students at a specific time in their vocational journey.

WHAT

An 8 week course that focuses on academic and applied content using a nationally recognized employment curriculum.

Our program is designed to:

- Teach students soft and hard transferable skills.
- Help students discover and explore careers that would appeal to their unique set of skills, interests, and challenges.
- Expose students to various local employers and employment fields through site visits, informational interviews, networking events, and volunteer opportunities.
- Provide opportunities for people with I/DD to learn the skills they need to obtain and maintain employment.

Program Requirements:*

- At least 18 years of age
- Diagnosis of autism or IDD
- Ability to participate and learn in academic and community settings in a small group (1:5 teacher to student ratio)
- Ability to communicate wants/needs and discomfort/illness
- Able to read and comprehend material at a middle school level
- Expressed desire and willingness to participate in the program
- Independent with hygiene tasks
- No recent history (within the last 6 months) of significant behavior requiring specific individualized interventions. Examples include but are not limited to; elopement, aggression, self-injurious behavior, sexual behavior, threats, hallucinations, or property destruction.





WHEN

Two days a week **9:00**am to **3:00**pm

Class Format:

9:00am - 12:00pm in a small group academic setting

12:00pm - 3:00pm in the community getting hands-on experience applying and practicing concepts covered.
